The new Open Enrollment Act interdistrict transfer law, also known as the Romero Bill, has been the source of much confusion and significant administrative analysis and leg-work. While the California Department of Education has issued a steady flow of guidance on the law since the early fall, only in recent weeks did the Office of Administrative Law approve the final regulations implementing the Open Enrollment Act proposed by the State Board of Education.
